This bill modifies the Massage Therapy Practice Act by providing continuing education requirements.

58-47b-306, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **58-47b-306** is enacted to read:

58-47b-306. Continuing education.

(1) As a condition for renewal of a license under this chapter, each licensee shall,

28 during each two-year licensure cycle, complete 24 hours of continuing education in
accordance

29 with standards defined by division rules made in collaboration with the board.

30 (2) If a renewal period is extended or shortened under Section 58-47b-303, the division
31 shall proportionately increase or decrease the continuing education hours required for

32 renewal under this section.
