AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the licensing of the profession of massage therapy

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1        Section 1. Subdivision 6 of section 7805 of the education law  
 2        added by chapter 498 of the laws of 2014 is amended to read as follows:  
 3        6. A massage therapist licensed AND IN GOOD STANDING in another  
 4        or country from conducting a teaching demonstration of modalities  
 5        techniques that are within the practice of massage therapy in connection  
 6        with a program of continuing education that is conducted by a  
 7        sponsor of continuing education by the department. ANY MASSAGE  
 8        THERAPIST CONDUCTING A TEACHING DEMONSTRATION OF MODALITIES AND TECHNIQUES  
 9        IN NEW YORK STATE PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE  
 10        PERSONAL AND SUBJECT MATTER JURISDICTION AND DISCIPLINARY AND REGULATORY

11 AUTHORITY OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS AS IF HE OR SHE IS A LICENSEE  
12 IF THE EXEMPTION PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION IS A LICENSE. SUCH  
13 THERAPIST SHALL COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE, THE F  
14 THE BOARD OF REGENTS, AND THE REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER, F  
15 TO PROFESSIONAL MISCONDUCT, DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS AND PENALTI  
16 PROFESSIONAL MISCONDUCT.
