6	a licensee employed as an instructor at the school, is exempt from § 17-86-		
7	311(a)(10).; and		
8	(4)(A) A person engaged in the practice of using minimal touch		
9	over specific points on the body to facilitate balance in the nervous system		
10	also known as Bowen therapy or Bowen technique, and is certified by a		
11	professional organization or credentialing agency that:		
12	(i) Requires a minimum level of training,		
13	demonstration of competence, and adherence to an approved scope of practice		
14	and ethical standards; and		
15	(ii) Maintains disciplinary procedures to ensure		
16	adherence to the requirements of the organization or agency.		
17	(B) The Arkansas State Board of Massage Therapy may verify		
18	that a practitioner claiming an exemption under subdivision (b)(4) of this		
19	section is certified by a professional organization or credentialing agency.
